Dear Parents

I would like to welcome your child back to school and I hope they all enjoyed the holidays!

My name is Miss Myers and I am pleased to be the new Year 3 teacher. I will be ably assisted by Miss Kaur who is our Teaching Assistant.

We have lots of engaging learning planned for our class for the rest of this school year and we hope to share our experiences and learning with you.

We will continue using the Class Dojo system for rewards. If you require the log-in information again I can send it home with your child. I am available through the messaging system so please do not hesitate to get in touch.

To help the year run smoothly there are just a few reminders and information you need to know.

- ◆ PE is on Thursdays and Fridays this half-term. All children will need a PE kit (white t-shirt, navy shorts or joggers and pumps for indoor and trainers for outdoor).
- ◆ Homework will be sent out on Friday to be returned the following Wednesday, unless otherwise stated.
- ◆ Spellings will go home on Friday with the test being the following Thursday.
- ◆ Mental Maths tests will be held every Monday.
- ◆ Reading books and reading records will continue to go home every day and will need to be brought back to school every day as well. Please record any reading in the reading journal so we can monitor your child's progress.
- ◆ Please can each child have a named water bottle in school. For children to learn well it is important that they stay hydrated.
- ◆ Please ensure all clothing that they will take off, including coats, has their name in it so we can get lost items back to you quicker.
- ◆ Only jewellery worn for religious reasons can be worn in school. If your child has ear-rings then they must be small studs only and need to be covered or removed for PE.
- ◆ The gate to the school opens at 8:30am and children must be supervised by parents/carers until their class teachers open the door at 8:50am
