In **English**, we will be writing non-chronological reports about Leeds, before designing a new city and advertising it. Following that, we will be writing a diary based on the World Cup.

In **Science**, we will be improving our investigative skills through a range of questioning topic areas and experiments. This will allow the children to consolidate the science learning across the year.

Mathematics - This half term we are analysing and drawing a variety of charts and graphs. We will then be focusing on different shapes, including their properties and angles. The final maths topic of the year will be position and direction. Translating shapes and plotting points on a co-ordinated grid.

In **Topic**, we will be learning about communities, both within school and in Leeds. We will be competing against each other to create PowerPoint to promote the school, with the winning presentation to be viewed on the school's TV screen.

The **International** aspects of our topic is to compare Leeds with other cities around the world.

In **PE**, children will be continuing swimming and will be taking part in cricket.

In **Spanish**, we are learning to talk about places around town.
